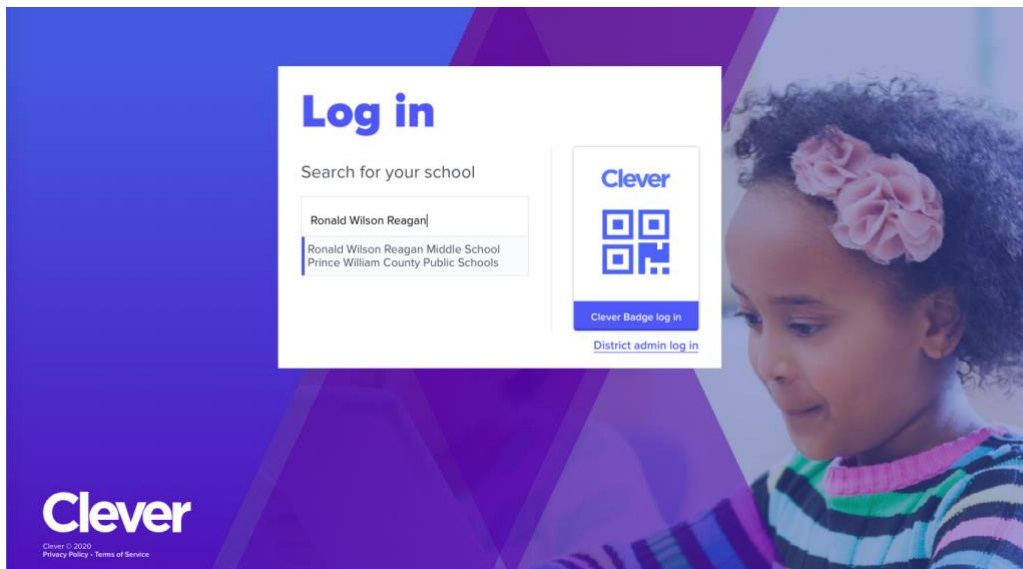
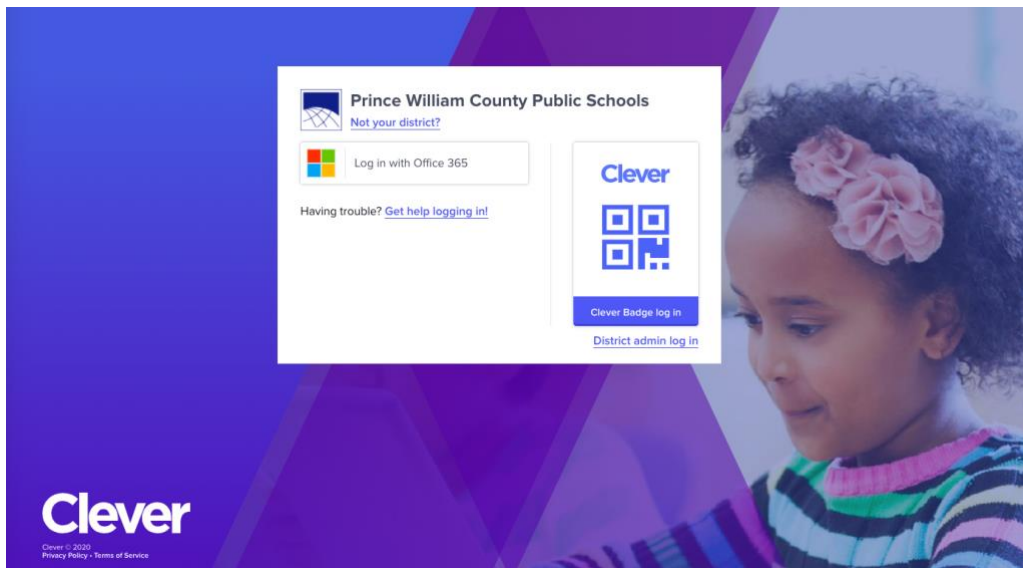


### How to log into Clever

1. Click this link/enter into the address bar: <https://www.clever.com>
2. Select **“Log in as a student”**
3. If the screen looks like this, type **“Ronald Wilson Reagan Middle School”** and hit Enter.



4. Click **“Log in with Office 365”**.



5. Select the Page you want to view. (This is what Ms. Park’s looks like – yours will differ.)
